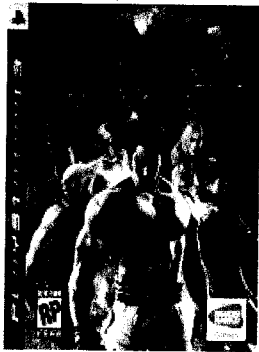
### Video Games

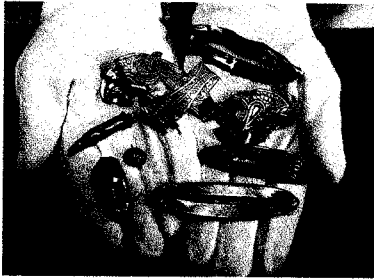

Last month in Staffordshire, England the largest treasure hoard of the Anglo-Saxon's was discovered. According to BBC News, the 1,500 gold and silver pieces found may date back as far as the 7th century and are unparallel in size and worth. These pieces were found by Terry Herbert, a farmer who has been using a metal detector for 18 years and regularly sweeps the fields of his farm. The treasure has been examined and is said to be mainly war paraphernalia, such as hilt plates and

sword pommel caps. The pieces have not all been thoroughly examined yet, however the British Museum has already purchased the items from the farmer. The pieces will be kept in Birmingham museum and Art Gallery until the pieces are ready for display. While the Anglo-Saxons influenced a major part of England's history, there is still a lot to be learned about these people and this treasure is a big key in charting their History.
