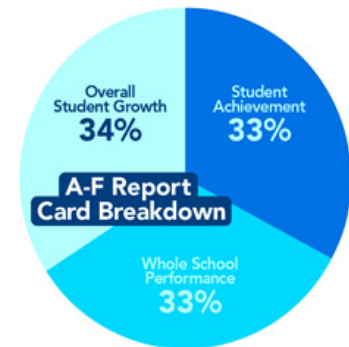

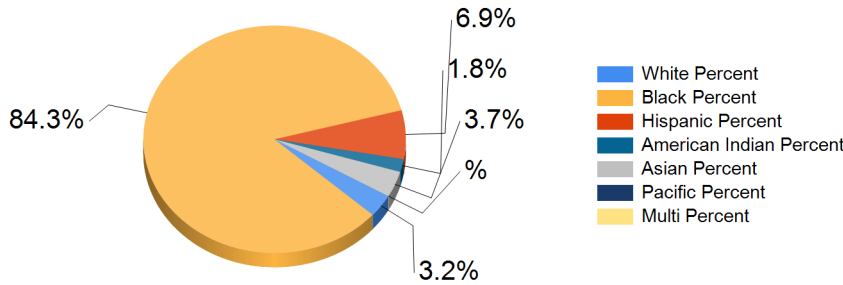

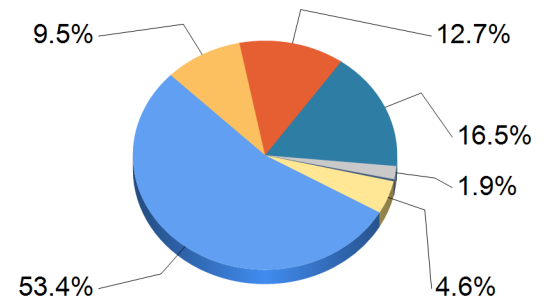

### ETHNICITY BREAKDOWN

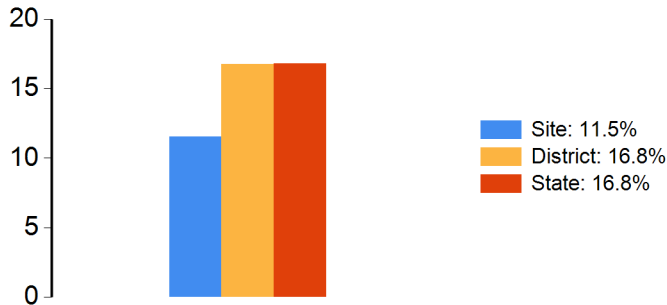


### STATE ETHNICITY BREAKDOWN



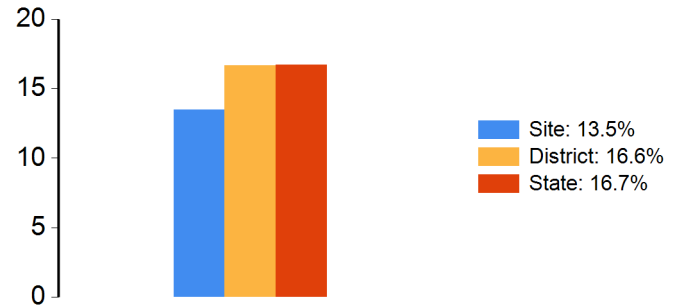

### PERCENT TESTED ON IEP (READING)



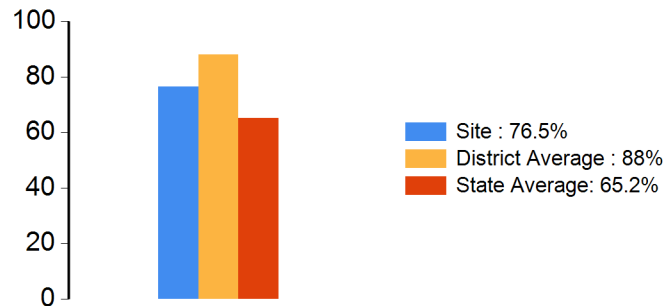
